### Zealan Hoover (he/him) External Advisor Environmental Protection Network

Zealan Hoover served as Senior Advisor to the Administrator and Director of Implementation for the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency from 2021 to 2025. In that capacity, he managed the deployment of over \$100 billion in new infrastructure and Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) investments to thousands of climate and environmental projects across the country, with more than 60% of that funding focused on disadvantaged communities. Hoover previously served as a policy advisor in the White House during the Obama Administration. He graduated from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

Annabelle Rosser is a Senior Policy Analyst at Atlas Public Policy where she contributes to original research and analysis on public investments in water and climate infrastructure.
